Important Notice to Affected Residents

The Hamilton Township Department of Water Pollution Control wants to keep residents informed of the upcoming sewer main lining activities on your block. These activities are scheduled to begin _____. No one should have to enter your home as part of these activities.

There will be an unavoidable service interruption while the plastic liner is curing inside the main sewer line. It is estimated that your interruption in service will be for an approximate _____ hour period, beginning _____. During service interruption, we ask that you **please limit your use of water in your house.** Limited use of the toilet or washing hands is acceptable. **Heavy water usage such as laundry, showers, baths, or running water for extended periods must be avoided** in order to prevent sewage from backing up into your house or basement.

Prior to lining, high pressure sewer cleaning will be performed. If a sewer trap or plumbing fixture is defective, backwash from the cleaning could go into your home through a fixture (toilet, sink, etc.). If this happens, please contact the phone number below.

Please be reminded that the lining material is plastic. During the lining process, an odor similar to glue may be noticed in low-level rooms such as basements. This odor should be barely noticeable inside any homes. If it should occur in your home, simply vent the area by opening nearby windows. If you have seldom used drains such as floor drains or unused bathrooms, please pour a gallon of water into the drain to refresh the trap. This will help block odor from coming into your home from the drain pipes. If odor should become significant in your home, please notify the construction crew and they will attempt to ventilate more aggressively in that area.

We again apologize for the inconvenience and ask for your cooperation and understanding by limiting water use and for temporary changes in traffic patterns. Roads may require detouring and there will be parking limitations. Thank you in advance for your patience as we conduct much-needed upgrades to the sanitary sewer system that serves your home and neighborhood.
