Nature of Work: Replace 10 sign structures and foundations

Anticipated Traffic Impacts:

Temporary lane closures during off-peak hours to establish the work zones and as required during construction. Work zones will be defined with concrete construction barrier.

Short duration full closures will be required when placing the overhead sign structures. These will be limited to 15 minutes with traffic allowed to flow freely between successive 15 minute closures.

Description of New Traffic Pattern:

Permanent shoulder closures with concrete construction barrier for the duration of the work at each location. More than one location may be worked on at a time.

Proposed Start Date of New Traffic Pattern:

February 1, 2010 (weather permitting)

All work is expected to be completed in Fall 2010.
