What is Radon?



- Radon is a radioactive gas that forms naturally when uranium, thorium, or radium break down in rocks, soil and groundwater.
- Radon gas is colorless and odorless.

Why should I test for radon in my home?



- Having your home tested is the only effective way to determine whether you and your family are exposed to high levels of radon.
- Radon exposure is responsible for more than 20,000 lung cancer deaths each year in the U.S.

How often should I test my home?



- If your living patterns change and you begin occupying a lower level of your home (such as a basement) you should retest your home on that level.
- Even if your test result is below 4 pCi/L, you may want to test again sometime in the future.
- If you are buying or selling a home.
- You have renovated or altered your home since you tested.
- The last test is not recent.
