WHEREAS, managing water responsibly is critical to our State's public and environmental health and to a high quality of life through economic commerce, power generation and recreation; and


WHEREAS, innovation in water conservation and water reuse will drive job growth and economic development and establish a 21st century paradigm of water management in the United States.
