Note: COVID-19 vaccinations may be available at your child's pediatrician. Please contact your pediatrician to see if they offer COVID-19 vaccinations to their patients.

The FDA and CDC have granted EUA approval of two vaccines for children as young as 6 months old:

Vaccine Manufacturer	Ages	Number of Doses in Primary Series
Pfizer	6 months through 4 years	3 doses
Moderna	6 months through 5 years	2 doses
