



Steps to Getting Married

Hamilton Township, Office of the Mayor



Select a Wedding Date & Time

In order for the Mayor of Hamilton to perform a wedding ceremony, the couple **must** have a **wedding date** chosen through the **Hamilton Township Mayor's Office**.

Please note that the Mayor of Hamilton **only** conducts wedding ceremonies on **Fridays**, with available time slots at **2 PM, 3 PM, and 4 PM**. A **\$50 wedding deposit** is **required** to secure the chosen date. The fees for township weddings are **\$100** for Hamilton Township **residents** and **\$250** for **non-residents**.



Make a Marriage License Appointment

To obtain a wedding license appointment from the Hamilton Township Division of Health, couples **must** first confirm their **wedding date** with the **Hamilton Township Mayor's Office**. Couples **must** apply for a marriage license at a minimum of two weeks prior to their ceremony by calling 609-890-3826 to schedule an appointment and pay a \$28 license fee.

Please note that **non-Hamilton residents** must **apply** for a marriage license in their **town of residence**.



Prepare for Wedding

To ensure a successful wedding ceremony conducted by the Mayor of Hamilton, couples **MUST** bring their **Marriage Certificate** with them. If the Marriage Certificate is not presented, the ceremony will be **anceled**.

Additionally, couples should bring **two witnesses** who are **over the age of 18** and have **photo identification**. If needed, couples should also arrange for any required **translators**.



Day of Wedding Ceremony

Weddings are conducted at the Hamilton Township Call Center, located at **5 Justice Samuel Alito Jr. Way**.

Couples getting married by the Mayor of Hamilton **and their witnesses** **must** arrive **30 minutes prior** to the ceremony to complete all necessary paperwork.
