#### VACANCY ANNOUNCEMENT

##### PART-TIME REGISTERED ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH SPECIALIST

The Township of Hamilton Division of Health is seeking a qualified individual for the position of part-time Registered Environmental Health Specialist (REHS) or REHS Trainee (approximately 20h/week). The schedule may be flexible to include days, nights, and some weekends to ensure availability to complete required inspections. The REHS shall be responsible for performing routine work involved in inspecting dwellings and other locations that are suspected sources of childhood lead exposures, this includes taking paint/dust samples, inspecting household items, liaising with contractors, reviewing scopes of work for lead abatement/remediation, and taking enforcement actions as needed. Additionally, the REHS would be required to safely operate lead analyzers and document findings within the state reporting system. The candidate must be able to effectively communicate with all residents, home owners, and building owners.

The position is funded by the NJDOH Childhood Lead Exposure Prevention (CLEP) grant.

Qualifications: The candidate should have knowledge of environmental public health issues, including but not limited to lead. Additionally, the successfully candidate must have an REHS license issued by the New Jersey Department of Health. The candidate must have or obtain a Lead Inspector/Risk Assessor Permit from NJDOH within 90 days of employment. The candidate shall demonstrate strong organizational, writing, and communication skills. Candidate shall have a Bachelor's degree in public health, environmental sciences, or a related field.
